As you are well aware, Palestinian women and children are living in tears and blood for over a month and not only are they deprived of their basic rights but are also a victim of the most heinous war crimes.

If you recall in our meeting on your last visit to Iran, you expressed delight that a university exists that is dedicated for the scientific and cultural growth of women. You pointed to your plans in enabling women and stressed that supporting women is a priority for UNESCO.

Madame Director General, how can we enable women and mothers in Gaza today, to be able to stop the rubbles from falling on their and their loved ones' heads?

What talent can we teach them to be able to bear holding the torn apart bodies of their children?

Is it true that there will be no school in Gaza's future, since in this ethnic cleansing, no other kid will exist in that part of the world?

The girls and women who are witnessing their loved ones' bodies covered with blood from day to day or children who scream and cry over the dead bodies of their mothers and sisters do not need support or enabling?

The Al-Zahra Women's society with close to ten thousand women students and hundreds of faculty members and staff feels the burden and sorrow of women and children in that region with all its heart and soul and asks you to seriously support women and stop the physical and mental damages inflicted on them and their families and use whatever means at your disposal to stop the attacks on schools and cultural centers in the region.

Without a doubt the crimes being committed now in Gaza will leave irreversible damages in the social and cultural future of women and children in this region.

Therefore the society of educated women of Al-Zahra fully supports the oppressed people of Gaza and expresses deep concern over ignoring the basic human rights of women and children in Gaza and the silence and lack of practical support of international societies from the people of Gaza.

We hope that your cultural-educational institution fulfills its vital mission in the current crisis and takes effective steps in supporting culture and education in this regard.
